We will continue this week's truth pursuit with Message 2 of the *Life-study of Matthew*, entitled The King's Antecedents and Status (2). This life-study covers Matt. 1:2. which address the persons of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah and his brothers in the Lord's genealogy.

Here is an excerpt from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

As the called one of God, not only was Abraham justified by faith, but he also lived by faith. As one called by God, he should no longer live and walk by himself, but live and walk by faith...What is an Abraham? An Abraham is a person who has been called out, who no longer lives and walks by himself, and who forsakes and forgets everything he has by nature...If we are true Jews, the real descendants of Abraham, we must leave everything and live by faith. We must forget about all that we can do and repudiate all that we are and have by nature. This is not easy. (Witness Lee, *Life-study of Matthews*, Living Stream Ministry, Anaheim, CA, msg. 2).
