We will continue this week's truth pursuit with Message 5 of the *Life-study of Matthew*, entitled The King's Antecedents and Status (5) His Birth. This life-study shows the mysteries and marvels of the birth of Christ, and His presence to us as Emmanuel in Matthew chapter one.

Here is an excerpt from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

Now we must clearly differentiate two points: Christ was conceived of the Holy Spirit and He was born of a virgin. His source was the Holy Spirit, and His element was divine. Through the virgin Mary as a means, He put on flesh and blood, the human nature, taking "the likeness of the flesh," "the likeness of men" (Phil. 2:7). However, He did not have the sinful nature of the fallen flesh. He knew no sin (2 Cor. 5:21), and He had no sin (Heb. 4:15). He had flesh, but it was the "likeness of the flesh of sin." In appearance He was made in the form of a fallen man, but in actuality there was no fallen nature within Him. His birth was exactly the same in principle. Apparently, He was the son of Joseph; actually, He was the son of Mary.

We must realize that Jesus is nothing less than God Himself mingled with fallen humanity, taking the form of humanity, but without man's sinful nature. This was the birth of Christ.

Matthew 1 not only gives us the origin of this King; it also gives us the presence of this King. This King's name is Jesus. Whenever we call on His name, we have the sense that He is ruling within us by saving us. He is setting up the kingdom of the heavens within us.

Key Verses for pray-reading: Isaiah 7:14, John 1:1, 14, Matthew 1:23

Questions:

- 1. According to the message, how can we say the birth of Christ was a great fulfillment of the prophecies in the Old Testament and why is this truth important?
- 2. Why was the Lord Jesus viewed by God as being in the form of a serpent when He was on the cross (John 3:15)?
- 3. What does the name Jesus mean and how does this name relate to us in our experience? Also, what name is the Hebrew equivalent and the Greek translation of Jesus? And what is the spiritual significance of this name?
- 4. In Matthew 1:23 we have another wonderful name--Emmanuel. Jesus was the name given by God, and Emmanuel was the name called by man. Emmanuel means "God with us." He is also Jehovah God, who was born in the flesh to be the King to inherit the throne of David (1:20; Luke 1:27, 32-33). Please try to connect these two points and explain how we can experience this Emmanuel as the King in our daily life?
