We will continue this week's truth pursuit with Message 9 of the *Life-study of Matthew*, entitled The King's Anointing (2). This life-study covers Matt. 3:1-12, which addresses the recommendation of the King by John the Baptist.

Here is an excerpt from this message followed by key verses for pray-reading and questions for your study:

John's baptism was only for repentance, to usher people to faith in the Lord. The Lord's baptism is either for eternal life in the Holy Spirit or for eternal perdition in fire. The Lord's baptism in the Holy Spirit began the kingdom of the heavens, bringing His believers into the kingdom of the heavens, whereas His baptism in fire will terminate the kingdom of the heavens, putting the unbelievers into the lake of fire. Hence, the Lord's baptism in the Holy Spirit, based upon His redemption, is the beginning of the kingdom of the heavens, whereas His baptism in fire, based upon His judgment, is its ending. Thus, in this verse (Matt. 3:11) there are three kinds of baptisms: the baptism in water, the baptism in the Holy Spirit, and the baptism in fire. (Witness Lee, *Life-study of Matthews*, Living Stream Ministry, Anaheim, CA, msg. 9, pp. 105).
