❖ Meeting Hall in Sao Paulo, Brazil

- Acquiring a property in São Paulo, that could serve the church in Sao Paulo and, the work of the Lord in Brazil, and even all of South America
- Excellent location and price, a four-story building with a total of 1,750 square meters (18,836 square feet) of usable space:
First floor can serve as a meeting hall with capacity to hold up to 500 people; second floor can be used for children's meetings; third and fourth floors can be used for the publication work; and a parking garage in the basement that can park up to 40 cars.
- Price of the property including the needed repairs is US\$1,563,600; currently have half of this amount; still lacking approximately US\$800,000.
- Schedule for payment: a deposit of US\$60,000; rest of the payment will be due in forty-five days.

Announcement of Upcoming Shepherding Trips

July 13, 2022

Dear Saints,

Since the war in Ukraine began on February 24, 2022, saints in the Lord's Recovery have been endeavoring to respond. Millions of refugees have entered Europe, mainly through Poland. Seven gospel trips have been conducted in eastern Europe. These trips took place mainly in April and May, the last one concluding on June 5. Based on what the Lord has been doing among the saints and through the gospel, there is a great need to feed the lambs. In order to meet this need, two "shepherding" trips have been held, and are scheduled to conclude on August 1. Based on the need, we are planning two additional trips to again focus primarily on shepherding Ukrainian saints, local saints, and new ones. We will concentrate on three cities: Warsaw, Krakow and Wroclaw in Poland, so the Lord can add to and strengthen the two important churches of Warsaw and Krakow, and expect that the Lord will raise up a lampstand in Wroclaw shortly.

The schedule is as follows:

Cycle P3: Dates: Aug 11-28

Deadline for registration: Jul 28

Cycle P4: Dates: Sep 8-25

Deadline for registration: Aug 25

We will be accepting a smaller number of participants than previous cycles, therefore we encourage Russian-speaking saints and those saints who have participated in previous cycles to register as soon as possible.

Language capability is highly necessary (primarily Russian and Ukrainian, however Polish will also be very helpful). English proficiency is mandatory. Mature or trained sisters are strongly encouraged to participate, as the refugees are mainly women and children. We request that the applicants take grace if they are not selected because our number is limited.

All participants must cover their own expenses including transportation, lodging and food. Upon approval, we can provide confirmation and more details, including suggested hotels.

Please do not book any tickets or hotels until you get confirmation emails from the Coordinating Brothers.

We request that all participants test negatively for COVID prior to coming. An antigen test administered at home is sufficient.

Please remember: The one accord is the master key to all the blessings; participants must be able and willing to coordinate with the local oversight. This is not a time for politics, the one new man must be our reality (no Ukrainians, no Russians, etc.). Thank you dear saints!
